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This Privacy Policy and Disclaimer (the "Policy") applies to the website easytoolsy.com (the "Website"). In this Policy, "we", "us", and "our" mean the operator of the Website and to everything offered on it. 4. Information We Collect

4.1 Information you provide

- Values, text, numbers, links, or files you enter into or upload to a tool in order to obtain a result.
- An email address and the content of your message, if you contact us.

Please do not submit sensitive personal information (health data, payment card or bank details, government identifiers, precise location, passwords) or other people's personal data through the Website. Inputs exist only to generate an on-screen result for you and are not intended to be retained as identifiable records. Where a tool runs entirely inside your browser, the data you enter is not transmitted to us at all.

4.2 Information collected automatically

- IP address (possibly truncated or anonymised), approximate country or region, and language preference.
- Browser type and version, operating system, device type, and screen size.
- Referring URL, pages and tools viewed, clicks, session duration, and date and time of access.
- Standard server log entries, retained for security, abuse prevention, and troubleshooting.

4.3 Cookies and similar technologies

Cookies, local storage, pixels, and similar technologies may be used to make the Website work, remember your preferences and recent tool settings, measure traffic, and — where applicable — deliver advertising. Where the law requires it, non-essential cookies are set only after you consent through the cookie banner, and consent can be withdrawn at any time.
